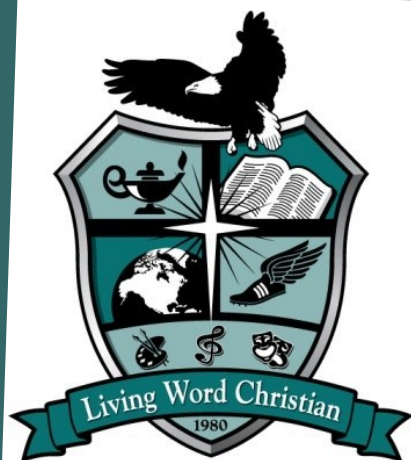

Every Spring CMS students take TerraNova achievement tests. 7th graders who score in the 95th percentile or higher in a core subject qualify for Duke Tip and can take the ACT/SAT. 50% of our 7th graders qualified for the Duke Tip talent search.

8th graders who score in the 95th percentile can qualify for the Joseph Baldwin Academy at Truman State University, an exciting college experience. 42% of our 8th graders qualified for the Joseph Baldwin Academy.
