



DRESS CODE

LWCS seeks to cultivate a wholesome environment that is conducive to learning. Dress code expectations are not intended to measure spirituality or to promote legalism, but rather serve as standards that enhance the teaching and learning environment, and preserve the ethos of the LWCS community. The following expectations have been instituted for regular school activities. Modest and appropriate clothing is expected at all after school events.

GENERAL EXPECTATIONS

- No athletic shorts or sweatpants other than LWCS issued sweatpants
- Shorts must be at least fingertip length when arms are by the side
- Appropriate undergarments should be worn, but not exposed
- No artwork or slogans with inappropriate words or images
- No exposed skin through holes or rips in clothing
- No writing on the rear of shorts or pants
- Hair must be clean, well-kept, and out of the eyes
- No hats, head coverings, or sunglasses are to be worn inside the building except for special, pre-announced spirit days

FOR BOYS

- No sleeveless shirts without a sleeved undershirt
- Pants should be worn at the waist
- No facial hair (Senior boys have the privilege of having facial hair if it is well kept)
- No body piercings are to be visible except for a single, small stud in the ear

FOR GIRLS

- Tops must be at least three fingers wide at the shoulder seam as measured by the student
- Dresses and skirts should be no shorter than 5 inches above the knee
- Leggings may be worn under dresses, skirts and shorts of appropriate length
- No exposed backs, midriffs, or cleavage
- No body piercings are to be visible except in the ears (Senior girls have the privilege of having a single stud, nose piercing)

FORMAL SCHOOL EVENTS

- Additional dress code requirements may apply, and prior approval may be required.

No dress code can address every possible situation. The faculty and staff reserve the right to decide if a particular item of clothing is not appropriate for the academic or school environment.
